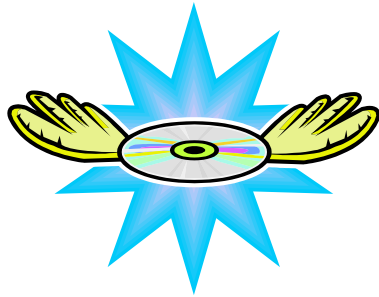

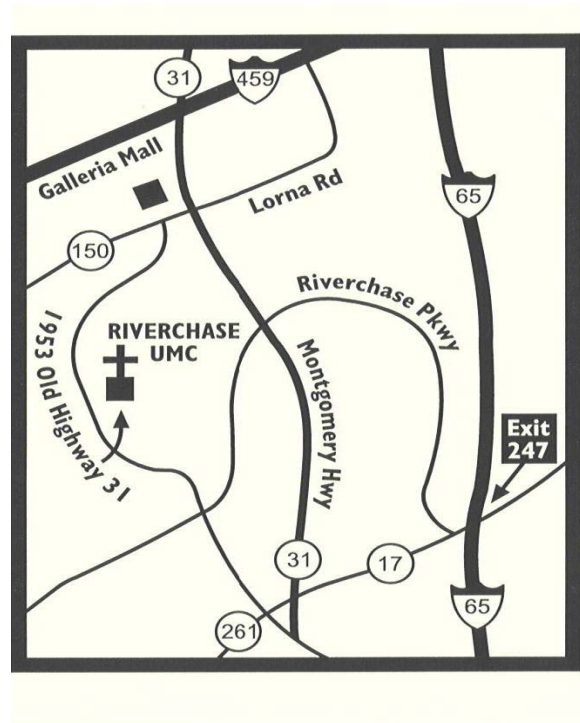

## *What you need to know to be an English tutor...*

Any person who desires to serve his neighbor can be a "Project Light" tutor. A



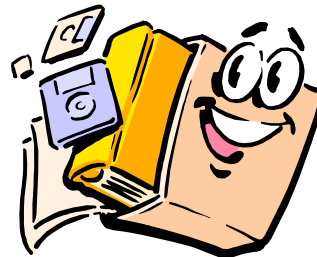
tutor does not have to be a trained educator. Project light will provide all the necessary training. You do not have to speak Spanish. The only requirement is to be able to speak and read English fluently and be a Christian. The curriculum is in the computer software. There is no planning or preparing lessons involved. All you have to do is sit with the student, correct his/her pronunciation and develop a relationship with the student.

Each lesson is taught one-on-one and contains a Bible lesson. Lessons are taught 1-3 times a week. 3 times a week is the ideal.

## **Our Training**

1. The first part of the training was developed by the US Department of Education.
2. The second part of the training is the Christian Literacy Series
3. The third part of the training is Conversational English.
4. The fourth part is GED classes taught on the computer.

Each session lasts 1 to 1 1/2 hours, 1 to 3 times a week.



## **Tutors are always needed!**

Students pay \$15 dollars a month to pay for supplies. There is no fee for tutors.

Assistance is available for those who cannot afford to pay for their classes.

Tutors may be all ages, from high school to retired senior citizens.
